



# Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 Notice of Proposed Special Event

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council has received an application from James Vallely that he wishes to hold Armagh International Road Races on The Mall, Armagh on Thursday 12 February 2026.

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Council gives notice that it is minded to make an Order to temporarily prohibit traffic. Mall East will be closed in both directions on 12 February 2026 between the hours of 5.00 pm and 9.30 pm. The left lane of Mall West in the direction of Goal Square will be closed between the hours of 6.00 pm and 9.30 pm. College Hill will be closed at Tower Hill between the hours of 5.45 pm and 9.30 pm. The inner lane will be closed on Barrack Street between the hours of 8.00 pm and 9.30 pm.

A diversion route will be signposted via College Hill, Drumadd Road and Victoria Street, Armagh.
