Learning and Development Policy & Strategy	The Learning and Development Policy & Strategy are new policies. They outline how learning and development is to be managed within the Council. The policy outlines the procedures on how training requests will be dealt with. Learning and development opportunities are open to all employees irrespective of section 75 category. The Council will continually review its learning methods so that they are suitable for a variety of disabilities. The provision of training assistance will be governed by the criteria of need, relevance to organisational objectives, staff development and cost effectiveness.	3
Surveillance Camera Systems Policy	This is a new policy. The purpose of the policy is to set out the appropriate actions and procedures which must be followed to comply with the Data Protection Legislation, the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 and other relevant legislation in respect of the use of surveillance camera systems (SCS) operated and managed by Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council facilities. This is a technical policy written to ensure compliance with statutory requirements and good practice. It has no bearing in terms of its likely impact on equality of opportunity or good relations for people within the equality and good relations categories.	3
