



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1997 NOTICE OF PROPOSED SPECIAL EVENT

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council has received an application from Armagh Athletics Club that it wishes to hold Armagh 10 Mile Road Race and 6K Fun Run on Killylea Road, Ballycrummy Road, Cathedral Road, Battleford Road, Knappagh Road, Elm Park Road and Navan Fort Road on Sunday 5 October 2025.

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Council gives notice that it is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit traffic from using Killylea Road from its junction with the Navan Centre and Fort, Armagh to its junction with and including the Ballycrummy Road, Cathedral Road, Battleford Road, Knappagh Road, Elm Park Road and Navan Fort Road, Armagh on Sunday 5 October 2025 between the hours of 8.00am and 1.00pm.

A diversion route will be signposted via Coolkill Road, Monaghan Road, Irish Street and Killylea Road, Armagh.
