

VOLUNTARY CODE OF CONDUCT FOR INLAND AMUSEMENT CENTRES

1.

This code is intended to cover the operation of all kinds of amusement devices and such other devices as are customarily used in the industry of amusement parks, amusement arcades, prize bingo and similar premises used wholly or mainly for the purpose of amusement catering.

- Persons under the age of 16 will be totally prohibited from entering the premises (18 if an Article 110 (1) ca Permit is granted.
- 3.

No Permit Holder/Manager will conduct his business in a manner that is likely to bring it, or the trade generally, into disrepute.

4.

No Permit Holder/Manager will do anything that is reasonably likely to cause annoyance or inconvenience to the public or to the occupiers of neighbouring premises.

5. Every Permit Holder/Manager will:-

- a. Keep his/her premises clean and in good state of repair and decoration;
- b. Ensure that all parts of his/her premises are kept adequately lit;

c. Ensure that the premises are adequately staffed and always in the charge of a mature and responsible person.

6.

The consumption of alcohol (other than in suitably licensed premises) is NOT PERMITTED.

- 7. The use or handling of drugs or other prohibited substances are FORBIDDEN.
- 8.

No Permit Holder/Manager will discriminate against, or will permit or aid discrimination against any person on the grounds of colour, creed, race or sex. Every person must be treated fairly and equally. However, no Permit Holder/Manager will allow any person leniency, undue favouritism or special consideration on the grounds of colour, creed, race or sex.

9. Permit Holders or Managers will, at all times, maintain their machines and games in efficient working order and will ensure that any equipment which may be found defective is withdrawn from use until it has been repaired.

10.

A Permit Holder/Manager will take all reasonable precautions to prevent disorderly conduct on his premises and to ensure that his premises are not used as a place of resort by undesirable persons, and reserves the right of admission at any time.

11. A Permit Holder/Manager may require that any person not playing the machines will be asked to leave the premises.

^{12.} A Permit Holder/Manager will only accommodate the machines of maximum payout under which his/her Amusement Permit allows.

13.

A Permit Holder/Manager will ensure that all fire safety precautions as required in his/her fire certificate are maintained at all times.
