Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council invites you to apply for participation in The Armagh Food and Cider Festival 2019, current winners of Tourism Northern Ireland's Food & Drink Experience of the Year.

Armagh Food and Cider Festival is set right in the heart of the Orchard County. Brimming with fine foods, sharing plates, foraged lunches, artisan markets, art tuition, fiction and even a murder mystery set amongst the apple laden orchards. Combined with award winning ciders and the most stunning surroundings, it offers visitors a harvest season treat.

The markets commence with a Sundown Market in Solitude Park, Banbridge on **Friday 20th September 4pm – 9pm**, followed by Artisan Food & Cider Market on **Saturday 21st September 12 noon – 10.00pm** in the Shambles Yard. These markets will be themed around the "Urban Orchard" concept. They will be branded in line with the Food & Cider Festival, everyone participating will be required to wear a Food & Cider Festival apron and all tables will have a branded table cloth.

The aim of these Artisan Food and Craft Markets is to offer a range of regional food products, which are not readily available within the Borough. The product offer should be distinctive, diverse and speciality and high quality.

We welcome and will give preference to applications from NI regional food producers in the sectors (Meat, Poultry, Fish, Dairy, Fruit, Vegetables, Bakery and Beverages). To be considered eligible an 'exhibitor' must showcase NI regional food defined as food grown/produced or processed in NI.

A limited number of non-food stalls may be considered if they are food/event connected, are made locally and offer the same diverse, speciality and high quality standards.

The number of traders with similar products may be limited. Should this happen, preference may be given to local traders and will take into account the nature of the product.

Only one, or possibly two, of each type of product will be selected based upon a scoring system. After scoring, if necessary and to ensure fairness, applications will be drawn from a hat.

A maximum number of four Hot Food stall spaces will be available, plus one stall space for tea/coffee vendor at the market in Banbridge. A maximum number of eight Hot Food stall spaces will be available, plus one stall space for a tea/coffee vendor at the market in Armagh.

A selection process will allocate stalls. Selection will be based on the APPLICATION FORM and SUPPORTING MATERIALS alone. The following information demonstrates how your application will be assessed and outlines the Selection Criteria. Previous attendance at the Food & Cider Markets does not guarantee re-selection and the panel can only select based on the information received this year. All supporting materials must be provided otherwise your application will be rejected.
