## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOU

Dear Customer

Introduction of updated estimated Building Cost Information, (BCIS) following a review of current building prices.

For building work not covered in Schedules 1 and 2\*, the Building Regulations fees are calculated based on a cost estimate for that work.

The legislation defines an ESTIMATE, in relation to the cost of carrying out building work, to mean a written estimate, accepted by a district council, of such reasonable amounts as would be charged for the carrying out of that work by a person in business to carry out such works.

As a valued customer, we would like to notify you that as of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023, this Service will be consulting the latest BCIS listings for 'current building prices', on receipt of an application to which the Building Regulation fee is related to the estimated cost of works\*.

This update is based on the revised figures which have been received from BCIS (Building Cost Information Services) which was set up by RICS (The Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors) to facilitate exchange of detailed cost information between Chartered Quantity Surveyors. These figures have taken account of the regional factor for Northern Ireland.

The use of BCIS Cost indices is used as a basis for reasonableness and is only applicable to the common construction works. Works of a higher specification may be assessed at a higher cost, and a written estimate may be requested.

For your convenience, we have attached/enclosed an up-to-date summary listing derived from the BCIS publication for your attention. You may wish to use these figures to determine your Building Regulation fees or alternatively, you may wish to submit a detailed estimated cost of works from a suitably qualified building professional.
