PLANNING AND REGULATORY SERVICES COMMITTEE MEETINGS RUNNING ORDER

- 1. Planning Officer presents application to Committee from top table via a powerpoint presentation with accompanying material reports/photographs/plans and makes a recommendation on whether the application should be approved with conditions or refused;
- Chair allows for any representations by Council Members (5 minutes) on behalf of applicant or objector(s) (only one Member to speak on behalf of each side);
- 3. Chair invites representations from objector(s) to the application (one nominated spokesperson (3 minutes));
- 4. Chair invites representations from applicant or supporter(s) of the application (one nominated spokesperson (3 minutes));
- 5. Chair invites members' questions to objector(s), supporter(s) and/or applicant;
- 6 Chair invites Planning Officer's comments
- Members debate including advice from planning officer and/or legal adviser;
- 8. **Members' decision** the Members take a vote on whether or not to agree with the planning officer's recommendation. The Chair has a casting vote.
