Home heating oil stamp saving scheme

Would you like to save in advance for home heating oil?

Now you can spread the bill and save for a fill!

What is the Keep Cosy oil stamp saving scheme?

It's a scheme designed to help householders who use central heating oil to budget and save to buy oil. Home heating oil is cheaper when bought in larger quantities. So saving over time is better than ordering small amounts on a regular basis.

Where does the scheme operate?

The scheme is open to all householders in the Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council area. Retail outlets selling oil stamps as part of this scheme are located throughout the borough.

There may be other local oil stamp schemes in operation in your area. Stamps from different schemes cannot be used on the same savings card.

How does the scheme work?

An oil stamp savings card can be obtained from one of the outlets listed opposite. Each £5 saving stamp is placed on the savings card. The card holds 40 stamps which is equivalent to £200.

You can buy stamps as often as you wish, allowing you to spread the cost of your home heating oil. The savings card can then be used as full or part payment for your oil with oil suppliers who are participating in the scheme.

How do I pay using oil stamps?

A card or a number of cards can be used as payment towards your heating oil. You do not need to fill all the stamp spaces on your card before using it to pay for your oil. The incomplete card will be accepted as part payment.

Each oil supplier taking part in the scheme operates differently. When you are ready to order your oil, contact your preferred participating oil supplier and let them know the amount of oil you require and the value of stamps you have saved.

As participating retailers and suppliers may change, it is your responsibility to agree the following with the oil supplier - price, delivery method and payment.

It is important to check with your chosen oil supplier to see how they expect to receive the card. Some may accept the card on delivery of the oil but others may prefer you to submit your card to them prior to the purchase.

Remember that you cannot use stamps from other schemes on the Keep Cosy savings card.

What if I lose my card?

Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council is not liable for oil stamps or oil stamp cards which are lost or stolen. Once the oil stamps have been sold, they are non-refundable from either retail outlets or from the council.
