



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (NORTHERN IRELAND)
ORDER 1997
NOTICE OF PROPOSED SPECIAL EVENT**

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council has received an application from Tracey Hughes, Founder and Secretary of Eva's Adventure Run to hold a half marathon, a 10k, 5k, and a 3k walk in the Tassagh, Annvale, Keady and Lislea area on Saturday 14th September 2019 from 8.30am to 11.30am.

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Council give notice that is minded to make an Order to restrict traffic as follows on the 14th September 2019 between the hours of 8.30am and 11.30am:

For the half marathon:

Dundrum Road to its junction with Tassagh Road
Tassagh Road to its junction with Annvale Road
Annvale Road to its junction with Darkley Road
Darkley Road to its junction with Victoria Street, Keady
Victoria Street and Bridge Street Keady to the junction with Kinelowen Street
Kinelowen Street to Armagh Road to its junction with Ballyards Road
Ballyards Road to its junction with Keady Road
Drumconwell Road to its junction with Ennislare Road
Ennislare Road to its junction with Killyfaddy Road West
Killyfaddy Road West to its junction with Dundrum Road
Dundrum Road to Tassagh Bridge

For the 10k route:

Dundrum Road to its junction with Tassagh Road
Tassagh Road to its junction with Bachelors Walk
Bachelors Walk to its junction with Armagh Road
Armagh Road to Kinelowen Street and Bridge Street, Keady
Victoria Street, Keady to its junction with Darkley Road
Tassagh Road from its junction with Kinelowen Street to the junction with Dundrum Road

For the 5k route:

Dundrum Road from Church car park to Tassagh Road to its junction with the Glen Road.

For the 3k walking route:

Dundrum Road to Tassagh Bridge and along the (Upper) Dundrum Road

Road restrictions will be advised at:

Dundrum Road on approach to Tassagh Presbyterian Church
A29 Darkley Road on approach from both directions to the junction with Annvale Road
Davis Street, Keady approaching the junction with Bridge Street
Kinelowen Street, Keady approaching the junction with Bridge Street
Keady Road, Armagh approaching the junction with Drumconwell Road in both directions.
