Rules

- Children **must** be dropped off and collected from the course by someone with parental responsibilities.
- Any child, who has to leave an activity at any time, must produce a note from his/her parent/guardian and inform staff.
- No form of bullying will be tolerated.
- All children are expected to respond to instructions given by the staff.

Terms and Conditions - please read

- Course confirmation will **not** be sent prior to the course. Only **unsuccessful** applicants will be notified.
- Places must be paid for at the time of booking and are non-refundable.
- For children wishing to register for both an Arts & Crafts and Sports course, two separate application forms must be completed.
- Telephone bookings will not be accepted.
- In the event of courses being over subscribed, places will be allocated on a first-come, first-taken basis.
- Receipts will only be issued on request.
- All courses are subject to revision, addition or cancellation should unforeseen circumstances arise, **including weather conditions and insufficient numbers**.
- Participants should arrive 10 minutes prior to the course session commencing and must be picked up **immediately** after the course session finishes.
