PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS ARE REQUIRED TO:

1. Identify a year group/class to participate
2. Nominate a teacher for the project, who will:
 - Undertake a partnership approach to project planning and delivery with the Project Lead and the artist/s
 - Inform Project Lead of any additional needs of participants to be considered in devising the content and delivery of the workshops
 - Be present at all times during the workshops
 - Complete a project evaluation report along with the artist (template supplied)
3. Agree to secure any necessary permission in relation to participants being photographed. Photographs will be used for project documentation and evaluation purposes and only by agreement with the nominated teacher.

4. Make available some pieces of work created by the participants for the Linen Lab exhibition at the FE McWilliam Gallery in October 2019, if requested

SELECTION CRITERIA

Schools will be selected on the basis of their ability to meet the above conditions, the strength of their application, and the following selection criteria:

1. Evidence of keen interest in visual arts education and collaborative practice
2. A balance and mix in the final selection of schools between the following: urban and rural, religious traditions, age range, and type of school - primary, secondary, special school, college
3. With consideration of the location of the school in regard to the Northern Ireland Multiple Deprivation Measures 2017 (according to NISRA)
