Responding to your feedback

Many of you very helpfully took the time to complete the Staff Opinion Survey. You'll have seen the results in the last leisure update, and the key actions following your feedback are listed below. The changes planned are:

- Sharing colleague feedback, thoughts or ideas
- Being a champion for change, providing feedback and helping implement successful change
- Supporting a range of communication initiatives (e.g. periodic photo or video updates on SLLC progress)
