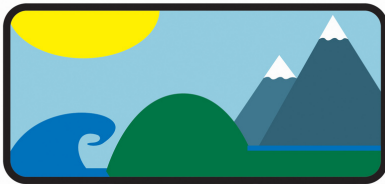

# WHY JOIN THE OUTDOOR PARTNERSHIP?

**Club membership** is available to all outdoor activity clubs and groups providing regular outdoor activity provision for residents in their area.

Full club membership is being offered for **FREE until March 2021** (usually £150 per year).



## Advice and support from our Regional Development Officer

### This could include:

- Guidance on club structure and governance
- Advice on skills, training and coaching qualifications
- NGB awards
- Advice on funding sources
- Or whatever help your club may need!

## Access to our Coach Education Programme

Volunteers in your club can gain qualifications at a heavily reduced cost.

Here's how it works:

- If you have a volunteer in your club who would like to do a course/courses to help with their role in the club, we can help subsidise the cost
- The volunteer will pay just £20 per day of the course cost – we pay the rest
- This can include First Aid courses, Safeguarding courses, Coaching qualifications, Leader Awards, Safety and Rescue Courses and Assessments
- Talk to your regional development officer to see if we support the course you would like to do!

## Access our new Mentoring scheme

Volunteers in your club can work intensively with a qualified instructor, to upskill and prepare for qualifications or get ready to coach or lead again after some time away.

### Here's how it works:

A coach in your club may have been inactive for a while and benefit from a day of working 1:1 with an instructor before becoming an active club coach again

Polish up some skills before a course assessment maybe?

Someone in your club may be interested in coaching but unsure if they have the right skills – a day with our mentor would give some great insight and help them on that first step

They can apply for one of our limited number of mentoring days – fill in an application form, letting us know what you want to do and why, and you could be a lucky winner!



**Costs just £20 for a full day working with our mentor**

## Inclusivity

Help and guidance on how to make your club more inclusive.

This could mean that you want to offer sessions or activities for individuals with physical impairments, and as such, need help with adapting equipment and activities so that wheelchair users can take part

Or it could simply be that your club gains better knowledge, tools and skills to make sure all your members are fully engaged and enjoy being a part of your club, whether they are hard of hearing, visually impaired, have a mild learning difficulty or any impairment you may not even know about!
