## Course Details

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### **Safeguarding Children & Young People in Sport (Online)**

This workshop aims to raise awareness of Child Protection issues in sport and introduces participants to the Code of Ethics and Good Practice for Children's Sport. This workshop is important for all adults involved in children's sport, but is particularly recommended for Coaches, Leaders, Administrators and Officials. The workshop which has been adapted for online learning is now delivered in two parts.

**Part 1:** Mandatory pre-learning that consists of a 25 minute video which is required to be undertaken in advance of the online workshop.

**Part 2:** Online virtual workshop via Zoom.

### **Emergency First Aid for Sport (Hybrid)**

This 6 hour workshop will cover elements of First Aid applicable to anyone who is responsible for coaching/supervising a team or individuals. A 3 year certificate of competency will be issued following successful assessment. Attendance at both sessions is compulsory.

**Part 1:** Online 3 hr theory session.

**Part 2:** Face-to-face 3hr practical session.

### **Income Generation, Fundraising and Sponsorship for Clubs (Online)**

This workshop delivered by Geoff Wilson will focus on how sports clubs can become financially sustainable by generating income from a variety of sources including sponsorship, fundraising and grants/foundations.

Geoff works with the likes of FIFA, UEFA, AFC, FIBA and other global sports organisations in a wide range of areas from strategic planning, marketing and communications, digital, fan engagement, public affairs and knowledge sharing/exchange programmes.

Geoff is a part-time lecturer in marketing at Queen's University Belfast, is former Chair of Netball Northern Ireland and is a current Board Member of Tourism NI.

### **Simple Steps to Club Development Planning (Online)**

This workshop highlights the importance of club planning and provides information on the simple steps that a club can take to create their own development plan, including creating a vision, objectives and actions, as well as who to involve. This workshop is delivered online. A pre-learning task is included as well as digital resources.

### **Designated Safeguarding Officer (Online)**

This workshop aims to support those undertaking the role of Designated Safeguarding Children's Officer in sports clubs including creating an awareness of key legislation and good practice, how to respond in a range of situations of concern and how to develop the standards of safeguarding within a club environment. Attendees must have attended 'Safeguarding Children and Young People in Sport' prior to attending this workshop and must be over 18 years of age.

This workshop will be delivered online in 2 x 1.5hr sessions.

Both sessions need to be undertaken in order to complete the workshop.

## How to Attract & Retain Club Members (Online)

This workshop highlights trends in sports clubs membership, how a club might develop membership 'insight' and considers how behaviour change concepts and practical steps may help to attract new members to your club, and retain existing club members for longer. The workshop is delivered via zoom.

## Level 2 Mental Health in Sport (Online)

Developed by Sport NI, this free 90mins interactive awareness workshop has been designed to build and embed mental health awareness and wellbeing into your club environment and culture. It will help members to support each other and identify issues that may be affecting someone's wellbeing.

### On completion of the workshop participants will have:

- Increased awareness of mental and emotional wellbeing and coping strategies
- Improved attitude towards mental and emotional wellbeing
- Improved awareness of signs and symptoms
- Increased awareness of appropriate sources of support.

## Disability Inclusion Training (Hybrid)

This 6 hour workshop has been designed to provide attendees with the knowledge and understanding they need to make their particular programmes, facilities and activities more inclusive of people with disabilities. Through a range of interactive exercises participants are made aware of the main barriers to participation, and are provided with practical advice and guidance to develop their ability to adapt games and activities to include all ability groups.

Participants will be introduced to a variety of warm-up games, activities and disability sports while given the knowledge of how to make these inclusive for all ability groups.

**Part 1:** Online 3hr theory session

**Part 2:** Face-to-face 3hr practical session.

## Creating Great Children's Sports Environments (Hybrid)

This workshop addresses the areas of children's coaching environments, coaching philosophy, the power of sport for child participant development and positive pedagogical climates.

**Part 1:** 60 minute zoom.

**Part 2:** 2 hour face-to-face practical session.

**Part 3:** 60 minute zoom reflection/implementation session.

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**Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis, however priority will be given to Coaches and Clubs within the Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council area.**
