Nomination Criteria

- 1. All nominees must reside in the Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council area.
- 2. Nominations are confined to performance/achievements between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2022 (please note the 2 year time period).
- 3. The nominee must be aged 18 years and under at the time of competition with the exception of the 'Coach of the Year' category. The coach may be over 18 but must be coaching Junior/Youth Individuals or Teams.
- 4. The nominee must be involved in a sport whose Governing Body is recognised by Sport Northern Ireland, Sport Ireland or UK Sport.
- 5. Senior Sports Awards 2022 achievements already recognised are not eligible.
- 6. Each nominee can only be nominated in one category.
- 7. Nominations will close on Friday 8th July at 5pm.
- 8. The ABC Sports Forum reserve the right to move nominees to other categories or create new categories as required.
- Nominations will be assessed by the ABC Sports Forum Selection Committee which will be chaired by a representative from Sport NI. Where necessary and appropriate the Committee will seek advice from external sources.

Nomination Guidelines

Detailed information should be provided about the nominee's sporting performance and/or outstanding sporting achievements between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2022 (2 year period).

Only information contained within the nomination form will be used for assessment.

For the following categories please list the <u>3 HIGHEST</u> achievements in <u>PRIORITY</u> order giving as much detail as possible. Junior Male, Junior Female, Junior School Team, Junior Club Team, Youth Male, Youth Female, Youth School Team, Youth Club Team, School Coach, Club Coach, Sports Person with a Disability

For the Young Volunteer category you will be required to write a short paragraph (500 words max) detailing their achievements for the time period 1 July 2020 – 30 June 2022.

Junior is 10 - 14 years at the time of achievement Youth is 15 - 18 years at the time of achievement

The Awards Evening will be held on Friday 14th October 2022 in the Armagh City Hotel.

The categories are as follows;

Sports Person with a Disability

This award recognises an individual with a disability, who has outstanding results/achievements in respect to their performances within their sport. Please note that depending on the nominations received this category may be further subdivided e.g. Sports Person with a Physical or Sensory Disability, Sports Person with a Learning Disability.

Junior Female/Youth Female of the Year

This award recognises an individual who has outstanding results/achievements in respect to their performances within their sport.

Junior Male/Youth Male of the Year

This award recognises an individual who has outstanding results/achievements in respect to their performances within their sport.

Junior School Team/Youth School Team

This award recognises a school team who has had outstanding results/achievements in respect of their performance within their sport.

Junior Club Team/Youth Club Team

This award recognises a Club team who has had outstanding results/achievements in respect of their performance within their sport.

School/Club Coach of the Year

This award recognises an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to coaching. This can be either through getting more people engaging and/or excelling in sport, or achieving school/club or athlete success.

Please note that nominees can be aged over 18 but must be coaching Junior/Youth athletes/players/teams

Young Volunteer Award

This award recognises an individual who has made an invaluable contribution with their sport as an administrator, coach or official. A volunteer is classified as someone who does not get paid for their services but may be reimbursed for out of pocket expenses. Please note to only record volunteering details for the time period stated ie 1 July 2020 – 30 June 2022 and only 1 nominee per club will be accepted.

As part of the media production on the evening we will require photos of the nominee and any video footage of them in action (high quality).
